#### Can I become a Parish/Town Councillor?

##### QUALIFICATIONS

A person is qualified to become a parish or town councillor if:

1. He or she is a British subject, or a citizen of the Irish Republic or other Euronational and on the day he/she is nominated as a candidate for election, is over 18 and an elector. AND
2. During the whole of the 12 months preceding his or her nomination day, or the day of the election, resided or had his/her principal place of work in the parish or town, or within 3 miles of it.

##### DISQUALIFICATIONS

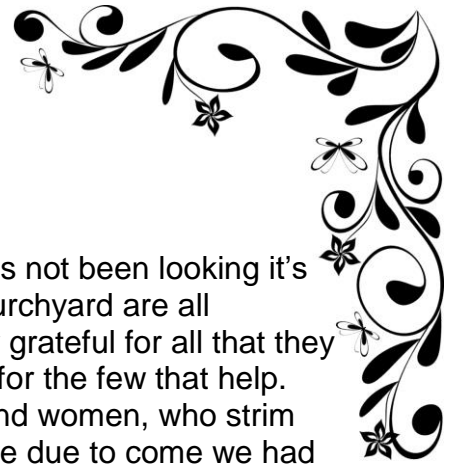
A person may not become a parish or town councillor if:

1. They hold a paid office or other place of profit in the gift of the Council.
2. They have been declared bankrupt in the past five years and have not repaid their debts.
3. They have been convicted of a criminal offence and sentenced to not less than 3 months imprisonment (including any suspended sentence) within the past 5 years.

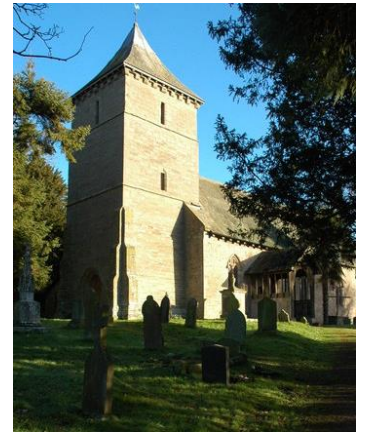

A very big thank you to everyone who has supported St Mary's over the last 3 months. Unfortunately we have not as yet re-established the fund raising committee but thanks to enthusiastic individuals we have had a coffee morning at the Vicarage, the Thomas Traherne Festival weekend and a book sale with refreshments. The PCC members are willing to come to individuals / organisations and help in any way which you feel would be useful.

We are currently enjoying a spell of good weather but the rain throughout April caused us many problems in maintaining the churchyard. Tom Fitch works extremely hard to keep on top of the many tasks in the churchyard and has been lucky to have help from the probation service. Unfortunately, the weather was so wet that they were unable to cut the grass and then the warm weather came, and the grass grew and grew. The maintenance group only come once a month and, in that time, it has become quite untidy. Tom feels that he is not able to work the hours that he has over the years and though he will continue to do as much as he can he would appreciate any help that anyone would like to offer. Churchyards are maintained by volunteers, except in the very well-off churches, yet people do expect them to be tidy and welcoming when they visit a relative's grave.
