Have Your Say – Hydrological Survey for Credenhill

Credenhill Parish Council is considering whether to commission a **Hydrological Survey of the Parish**.

A hydrological survey would assess surface water drainage, groundwater levels and potential flood risk across the parish. This information could help the Parish Council better understand local water issues, inform responses to planning applications, and support future funding bids for drainage or flood mitigation works.

The estimated cost of the survey is approximately £4,000. The Parish Council would only proceed **if funding can be secured from external agencies**, meaning there would be no direct cost to local residents through the parish precept.

Before taking any further steps, councillors would like to understand the views of residents.

- **Object** to the proposal?

The Vicar's Letter



Dear Friends,

The angel's words at the tomb are wonderfully blunt: "You are looking for Jesus the Nazarene, who was crucified. He has risen! He is not here." Mark 16:6

It's almost as if the angel is saying, "Yes, you're in the right place... but with the wrong expectation."

And honestly, many of us still stand with the women at the tomb, blinking in the early light, thinking, "A risen Jesus? Really?" Even the first disciples didn't respond with serene confidence. They were startled, confused, and probably one step away from asking for a second opinion.

But the resurrection was never meant to be a natural event. It wasn't Jesus stretching his legs after a long nap. On that level, it would be impossible. The heart of Easter is that God acted and breathed life where death had closed every door.

Three things steady us when belief feels wobbly:

- The empty tomb — not explained away, not tidied up, simply... empty.
- The changed disciples — frightened people don't usually risk their lives for a story they made up over breakfast.
- The character of God — the One who creates, restores, surprises, and occasionally rewrites what we thought were the rules. The resurrection isn't a quirky medical anomaly; it's God doing what only God can do. If we're going to believe in a Creator, we might as well allow for the occasional divine plot twist.

So if you find yourself at the tomb with questions, you're in good company. The first Easter began with bewilderment too. And yet, in that bewilderment, hope broke in.

The angel's message still stands: He is not here. Which is another way of saying: look for him where life is stirring, where hope is rising, where love refuses to stay buried. And perhaps the invitation for us is to stay open to the possibility of resurrection and not to force certainty—because if God can roll away a stone, God can probably cope with our questions.

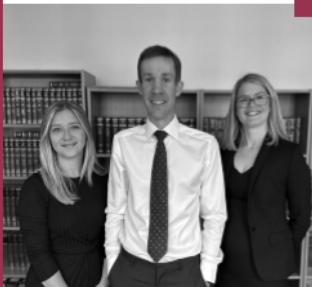

The VIKINGS ARE COMING!

Save the date: 30 & 31st May, Leominster Priory

Not to be missed: the Vikings invade Leominster (again). A pitched battle will take place in the Grange near Leominster Priory at 3pm both Saturday and Sunday afternoon of 30th and 31st May, Vikings v Saxons. This is the highlight of an action-packed family-friendly weekend featuring re-enactors from Regia Anglorum. There will be a living village to explore, with demonstrations of Viking/Saxon life, arts and crafts, a fashion show, plus a chance to experience their music, religious services, and warrior training.

A full-sized replica Viking ship inside the Priory is a must-see, part of a free exhibition, open daily 10-4, exploring the significance of the Vikings in Herefordshire and the culture and art of the Anglo Saxons. Get a close-up look at the (replica) Herefordshire Hoard – the fabulous treasure trove buried in the 9th century and re-discovered just outside the town in 2015. The exhibition features the first public view of ‘The Hereford Gospels Today’, together with art inspired by the Hereford Cathedral Saxon Gospels, including illuminated art by Marches Scribes and the work of students from Hereford College of Art. There will also be thought-provoking displays by local artists and community groups inspired by the theme of treasure.

The May weekend is part of a month-long series of free and paid events in and around Leominster Priory. With guided walks, talks, concerts, drama and craft workshops, there is something for everyone, and activities to appeal to all ages.
