There is a 10 minute slot at the beginning and end of the meeting for public question time where members of the press and public can comment or ask questions about parish matters.

Welcome to New Councillor Paul Nicholas

We would like to welcome Paul Nicholas to the Parish Council following his co-option at the April meeting. Paul recently moved to Credenhill and has also volunteered to deliver the magazines to the new Oakfield View Estate.

Section 106 Funds—Oakfield View Estate

Now that the new estate is complete the developer has paid the Section 106 funds to Herefordshire Council for local amenity improvements totals as follows:

Education - Enhanced Educational infrastructure at St Mary's Primary School and Weobley High School - £252,352.76

Waste and Recycling - One waste collection bin and one recycling collection bin to be provided for each dwelling - £6,366

Sports - Sports facility improvements at Roman Park - £45,360.18

Transport - Any of the following facilities to be used to serve the Development and the monies shall be used by Herefordshire Council, in consultation with the Parish Council, at its option for any or all of the following purposes: Installation of gateway features, lining of carriageway and Speed Indicator devices; Provision of dropped kerbs on footpaths through the village; Cycle infrastructure improvements; Bus infrastructure improvements. - £128,394.96

We will be working closely with Herefordshire Council to ensure these funds are spent in the Parish - what would you like us to spend it on?



Grants for Local Organisations

At the April meeting we considered grant applications from a number of organisations and we are pleased to confirm that the following grants have been made:

Parish Church Committee of Credenhill	800.00	Employ contractor for Churchyard maintenance for 8 days per year to supplement work completed by volunteers.
Headway	575.00	Desktop Computer for Service Users

New Development - up to 250 Homes North of Granary Cottages

Additionally the Parish Council agreed to hold funds for other organisations once they had completed the relevant paperwork.

Under the Labour's new Housing policy, Herefordshire is required to build 27,260 houses by 2046 which means Credenhill will need to supply 285. You will see on the next 2 pages the first draft of a potential new housing development in Credenhill. The local land owner has recently received preplanning application advice from Herefordshire Council, conducted the relevant surveys and is now seeking the views from local residents about the initial ideas. This informal consultation will be open until 15th May. Following this, the applicant will submit a planning application when the formal consultation will start through Herefordshire Council.

Dear Friends,

The VIKINGS ARE COMING!

Save the date: 30 & 31st May, Leominster Priory

Not to be missed: the Vikings invade Leominster (again). A pitched battle will take place in the Grange near Leominster Priory at 3pm both Saturday and Sunday afternoon of 30th and 31st May, Vikings v Saxons. This is the highlight of an action-packed family-friendly weekend featuring re-enactors from Regia Anglorum. There will be a living village to explore, with demonstrations of Viking/Saxon life, arts and crafts, a fashion show, plus a chance to experience their music, religious services, and warrior training.

A full-sized replica Viking ship inside the Priory is a must-see, part of a free exhibition, open daily 10-4, exploring the significance of the Vikings in Herefordshire and the culture and art of the Anglo Saxons. Get a close-up look at the (replica) Herefordshire Hoard – the fabulous treasure trove buried in the 9th century and re-discovered just outside the town in 2015. The exhibition features the first public view of ‘The Hereford Gospels Today’, together with art inspired by the Hereford Cathedral Saxon Gospels, including illuminated art by Marches Scribes and the work of students from Hereford College of Art. There will also be thought-provoking displays by local artists and community groups inspired by the theme of treasure.

The May weekend is part of a month-long series of free and paid events in and around Leominster Priory. With guided walks, talks, concerts, drama and craft workshops, there is something for everyone, and activities to appeal to all ages.
